- I. The Psalmist Expressed His Trust in the Lord (131:1-2)
 - A. By His Abandoning Pride (131:1)
 1. He Abandoned a Prideful Disposition (131:1a-b)
 - proud high or exalted
 - haughty high or exalted
 2. He Abandoned Prideful Expressions (131:1c-d)
 - involvethe act or process of living life
 - great important or large
 - difficult extraordinary or wonderful
 - B. By His Fostering Humility (131:2)
 1. The Psalmist's Statement
 - composed to make even or level
 - quietedsilent or inactive
