### Pentateuch

penta – *pente* – 5

Pentateuch – “the book consisting of five parts”

- Names of Parts of the Pentateuch:
  - 1) Genesis – *Beresit* – “by way of beginning”
  - 2) Exodus – *we’ elleh semot* – “and these are the names”
  - 3) Leviticus – *wayyiqra* – “and he called”
  - 4) Numbers – *bemidbar* – “in the wilderness”
  - 5) Deuteronomy – *elleh haddebarim* – “these are the words”
  
- Mosaic Authorship:
  - Testimony of Scripture (2 Chron. 25:4; 35:12; Mk. 12:26)
  - Character of the Man:
    - He was an Eyewitness
    - He was Highly Educated
    - He was Familiar with the Region
    - He was Motivated
